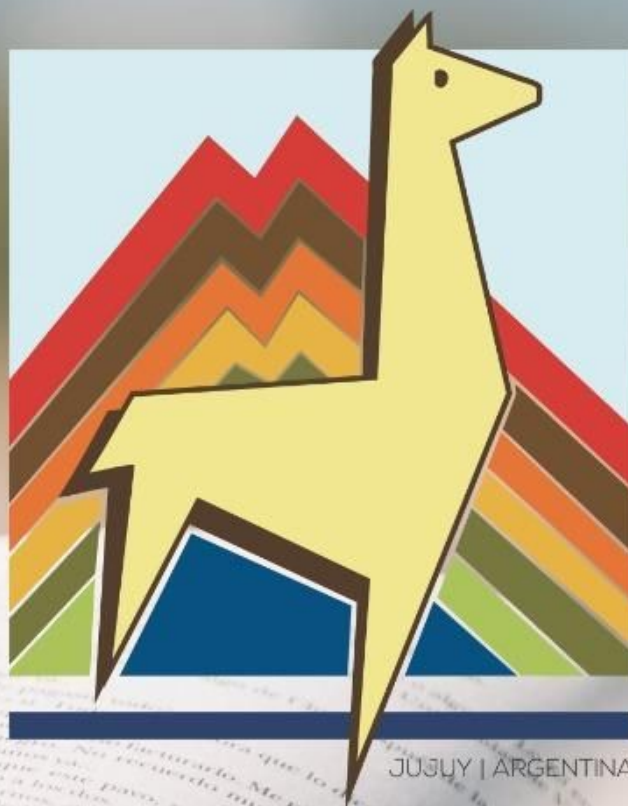

EDUCATION IN PROSPECTIVE. DISRUPTIVE PRACTICES MEASURED BY TECHNOLOGIES.

PRESENTATION

The University Network of Distance Education in Argentina (RUEDA) is a network which within the framework of the National Interuniversity Council (CIN), integrates public higher education institutions (universities and university institutes) planning and organizing activities in the perspective of inclusion of Information and Communications Technology (ICT) for pedagogical mediation in higher education.

Since 1989, RUEDA organizes academic meetings in order to collaborate on the production and spreading of knowledge about Distance Education and Educational Technology. In this way, and based on the joint initiative of the network's member universities, 7 seminars have been held to date (7 international and 1 national); in 1989 and 1993 (UBA - Buenos Aires); 1988 (UNC - Córdoba); 2003 (UNMdP - Mar del Plata); 2006 (UNC - Córdoba); 2010 (UNCPBA - Tandil); 2013 (UNCUYO - Mendoza); and 2016 (UNL - Santa Fe).

On 7 and 8 October 2019, the 8th International Distance Education Seminar will take place at the National University of Jujuy, Jujuy, Argentina. Under the motto "Education in prospective, disruptive practices mediated by technologies".

The RUEDA summons experts, researchers, teachers, students and other stakeholders interested in the problems of Distance Education and Educational Technology, in order to create a place for discussion, cooperation, production and scientific and academic spreading.

TOPICS OF THE SEMINAR 2019

The relevant topics around which this International Seminar will be developed and in which the papers to be presented should be framed are:

Axes	Dimensions
1. Emerging Technologies	Virtual, Mixed, Augmented Reality. Gamification. Video Games. Simulations. Artificial Intelligence. Robotics.
2. Access to information	Digital library. Institutional repositories. Open and shared access. Collaborative communities and licenses. Copyright. University publishers.
3. Teaching practices in convergence	Immersive learning. Youth cultures and learning. Alternative evaluation. Processes of teaching and learning combined. Social networks and educational processes. Disruptive experiences mediated by technologies in high school.
4. Challenges in the implementation of information systems	Convergence of systems for academic management. Adaptation of systems to different needs of higher education. Innovations located.
5. Materials and devices for learning	New formats and designs. Platforms and open environments. Materials for ubiquity and convergence. Mobile devices.
6. Institutional context, regulations and communities of practice	The regulation of Institutional Systems of Distance Education. Educational institutions, programs and projects. Educational social inclusion programs. The institutionalization of distance / virtual education. Evaluation of educational projects.

EXPECTED ACTIVITIES

Conferences and Panels

The Conferences and Panels will be addressed by national and international experts and prestigious referents in each of the six topics mentioned.

Exchange workshops

Following the modality implemented by the VII International Seminar held in 2016, these workshops will gather a small group of participants whose works have been approved for their communication. The workshops are organized based on

a common topic and with the aim of discussing and exchanging problems, conceptual developments, findings and challenges.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Scientific Committee of the VIII International Seminar will accept for its evaluation:

- Researchs
- Reports, Experiences and
- Essays

All the works must respond to any of the topics, which have been foreseen for this event.

Abstracts will be receive for evaluation.

No more than two papers per author will be accepted.

Works signed by more than three co-authors will not be accepted.

At the following address: <http://seminariorueda.unju.edu.ar> the registration is available in the "Inscripciones" button of the website's navigation menu, where you must attach the abstract.

The submitted abstract should be a **structured** text that contains the following information (maximum of 3000 characters):

- Introduction with the objectives
- Methodology
- Results
- Conclusions

PRESENTATION OF COMPLETE WORKS

All accepted papers will be published in digital format on the Website of the VIII International Seminar, with its corresponding ISBN.

The complete works must:

- Contain between 8 (eight) and 12 (twelve) pages, plus the corresponding annexes.
- Send in doc or docx format
- Follow APA standards 6th edition, both for the body of the text and in the citations or the bibliography at the end of the work.

Format of presentation:

- On A4 paper; Arial typography; font size 11, spacing 1.5; margins 2.5 cm (all).
Titles: Arial font, font size 12, bold style.
- Title of the papers: bold, centered.
- Names and Surname of Authors.
- Institution to which they belong.
- Main topic for which communication is proposed.
- Type of work (research, report, experience or essay).
- Keywords (5 words).
- Abstract should be less than 200 words. The abstract must be included in Spanish or Portuguese; and in English.

According to the type of work, they should develop:

- The objectives of the communication.
- The methodology used (in the case of researchers).
- Developing.
- The advances, findings and / or results (in the case of researchers).
- Substantiated Conclusions (in the case of the experiences and trials reports).
- Bibliography.
